NJ Synod

The NJ Synod met in Assembly on June 5-7 at the Hilton, East Brunswick. 376 voting members and 59 visitors worshiped, celebrated, elected a bishop, and conducted the synod's business during these days.

Through a process of prayer and discernment, the assembly elected The Rev. Dr. Christa Compton (Gloria Dei, Chatham) to serve as the next bishop of the NJ Synod. Pastor Compton was elected on the fifth ballot. Results of all the ballots can be found on the synod website (njsynod.org/assembly). We thank all of those who allowed their names to go forward in this election process. Pastor Compton's term begins on September 1, 2025. Until that time, Bishop Bartholomew

continues in office. Please respect Pastor Compton's transition time as she bids farewell to the congregation she has served for 12 years, moves, and gets oriented to this new call. Now is not the time to contact her for
